Minutes of Previous Meeting

Matters Arising

The neighbourhood watch signs have now been put up.

Replacement of the bulbs in the footway lights has now been completed and it was felt this has improved the lighting around the village and has proved to be a good solution.

The speed limit sign has now been returned to Grainthorpe. It is hoped they will be able to fix it before our next turn.

Dog fouling. It was agreed we should still seek advice from the dog warden concerning this issue. Clerk to action asap.

Planning

The applications in relation to The Chestnuts and Algemobry have now been approved and it is felt both will improve the village's housing stock.

It was noted the application regarding The Grange has been rejected.

A further application has been received in relation to a proposed extension at Corner Cottage North End. It is quite a large extension that is proposed but given the location of the property there are no objections.

Treasurers Report

In the absence of Councillor Cummings, the E mailed report he has submitted prior to the meeting was read out and its contents approved by Councillor Wahlberg. The Clerk reported that we have yet to have confirmation from Grant Thornton that the audit of last years' accounts has been completed.
