

NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE WATER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the North East Lincolnshire Water Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") are about to apply to the Secretary of State for the Environment for an Order under section 23 of the Water Act 1945, as extended by section 3 of the Water Act 1948.

The general effect of the Order will be:-

1. To empower the Board to construct, maintain, renew and alter the following works in the county of Lincoln -  
Parts of Lindsey:-

In the rural district of Louth, in the parish of  
Alvingham -

Work No. 1 - A line or lines of pipes, together  
with an electrical control cable;

Work No. 2 - A pumping station at Austen Fen Lock;

Work No. 3 - An access road between High Bridge  
Road and Work No. 2;

Work No. 4 - A line or lines of pipes, together  
with an electrical control cable;

Work No. 5 - A storage reservoir, covering  
approximately 260 acres;

Work No. 6 - An access road;

Work No. 7 - A line or lines of pipes, together  
with an electrical control cable;

In the rural district of Louth -

Work No. 8 - An extension of the existing  
treatment works in the parish of Covenham  
Saint Bartholomew;

Work No. 9 - An electrical control cable between  
the said treatment works and Work No. 2 in  
the parishes of Grainthorpe, Covenham Saint  
Bartholomew, Covenham Saint Mary and  
Alvingham.

In the rural district of Grimsby -

Work No. 10 - A covered service reservoir,  
covering approximately 12 acres, and  
a pumping station in the parish of New  
Waltham.

2. To authorise the Board to acquire compulsorily lands or easements in land in the parishes mentioned above for the purpose of the construction of the proposed works (with power to reinstate owners or occupiers of land so acquired) and temporarily to stop up, alter, divert or otherwise interfere with highways, drains or private rights of way.
3. To authorise the Board to stop up and divert a portion of a footpath in the parish of New Waltham in the rural district of Grimsby, for the purpose of the construction of Work No. 10.
4. To authorise the Board to borrow money.
5. To incorporate or apply, with or without modification, all or some of the provisions of the Railways Clauses Consolidation Act 1845, the Compulsory Purchase Act 1965 and the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945 including an extension of the provisions of Part V of the said Third Schedule in relation to lands in the rural district of Louth.

Copies of the draft order and of the relevant plans and sections have been deposited at the offices of the Board at Town Hall Square, Grimsby and at the offices of the Clerk of the Louth Rural District Council at the Council Offices, Cannon Street, Louth and may there be inspected by any person free of charge, at all reasonable hours from the date of this notice until 24th June 1972.

Copies of the draft Order may be purchased at the said offices of the Board and at the offices of the undermentioned Parliamentary Agents at the price of 10p each.

Any person desiring to bring before the Secretary of State for the Environment any objection to the application for the Order may do so by notice addressed to the Secretary, Department of the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London, SW1P 3EB quoting reference number WS/3072/23/9 and despatched on or before the 24th June 1972. It is requested that a copy of any such objections should be sent at the same time to the undermentioned Parliamentary Agents.
