Water Acts 1945 and 1948

North East Lincolnshire Water Order

In pursuance of paragraph 2 of the Schedule to the Water Act 1948 we enclose notice of an application which is being made by the North East Lincolnshire Water Board to the Secretary of State for the Environment for an Order under section 23 of the Water Act 1945, as extended by section 3 of the Water Act 1948 and section 33(2) of the Compulsory Purchase Act 1965. The same notice is being published in local newspapers in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2 of Schedule 1 to the Water Act 1945.

The notice is served upon you as the reputed owner, lessee or occupier of land which will be liable to be acquired compulsorily, or in respect of which easements or rights will be liable to be acquired compulsorily, if the Order is made by the Secretary of State. The purposes of the Order are explained in the notice and, as stated in the notice, copies of the draft Order and of the relevant plans are available for inspection at the offices of the North East Lincolnshire Water Board at Town Hall Square, Grimsby and at the offices of the Clerk of the Louth Rural District Council at the Council Offices, Cannon Street, Louth.

We also enclose the Board's statement of the reasons for the scheme of works proposed in the draft Order and explaining the need for seeking powers to acquire lands or rights in land.
