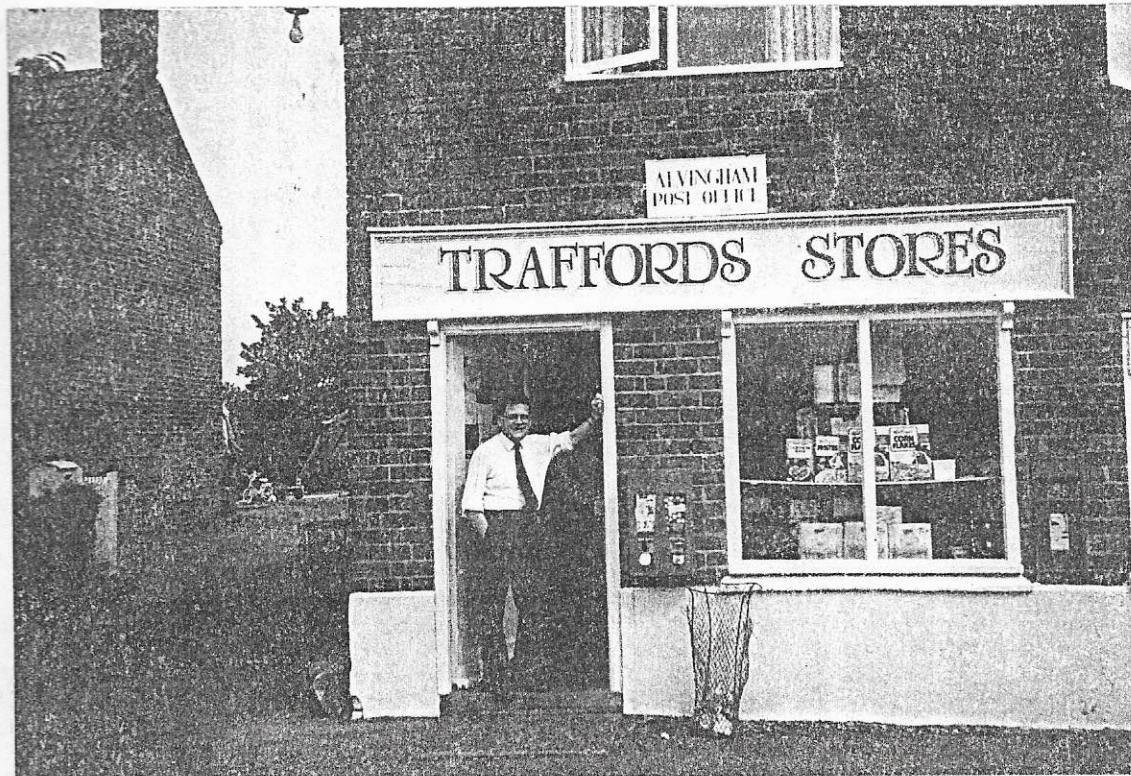


FEBRUARY 1994
