

PROPOSED RESERVOIR ALVINGHAM

That this open meeting of the inhabitants of the village of Alvingham, held at Alvingham on Friday, 24th November, 1972, views with very great concern the intention of the North East Lincolnshire Water Board to construct a pumped storage reservoir on some 250 acres of land in very close proximity to the village.

The meeting fully supports the Alvingham Parish Council in its representation to the Secretary of State for the Department of the Environment and request that the strong objection of the village of Alvingham to this development be clearly appreciated by the Planning Authority and brought to the close attention of the Department's Inspector at the forthcoming Public Local Inquiry on 12th December, 1972.
